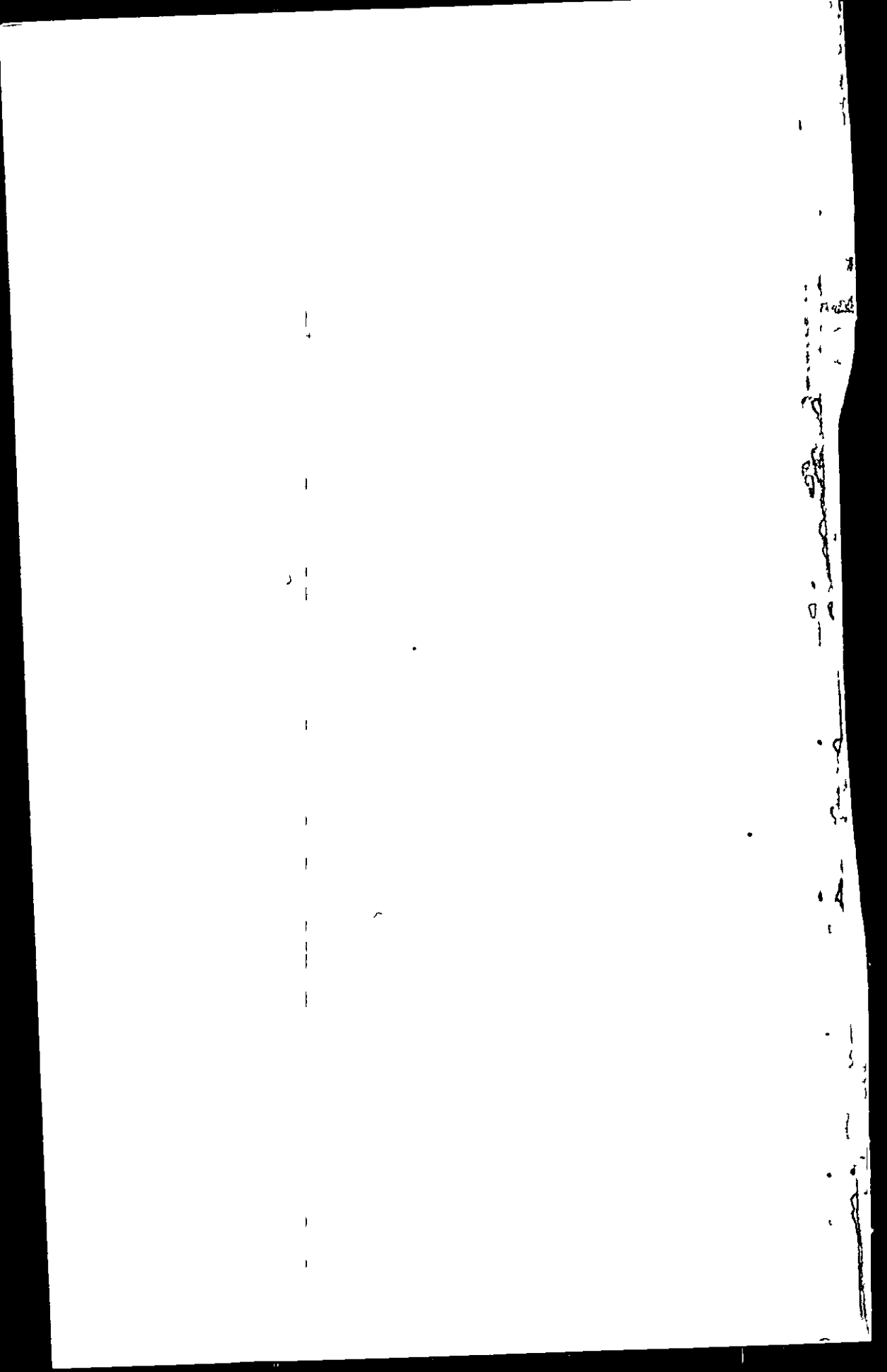

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### EXPLANATORY NOTES

The Census particulars were collected in respect of 12 May 1946. Provision was made on the Census schedule for the furnishing of information in the case of each married man, widower and widow, of the number of living sons, daughters, step sons and step daughters under 16 years of age, whether residing as members of the household or elsewhere, and the statistics contained in this volume are based upon the analysis of the information thus furnished. The heading on the Census schedule was as follows—

O *Particulars of Present Marriage*

(a)

(b) If person is married man, widower or widow, write number of *living* sons, daughters, step sons and step daughters under 16 years, whether residing in this household or elsewhere. If none, write none.

The definition of a dependent for the purposes of this enquiry was therefore limited to living children and step children under 16 years of age who were recorded in respect of married men, widowers and widows. This definition is the same as that used at the 1926 Census Enquiry, and the statistics presented in this volume are therefore comparable with those in the corresponding volume of the 1926 Report.

The total number of children under 16 years of age recorded at the Census was 875,302. A considerable number of these cannot be accounted for as dependents since the question was restricted to the children of married men, widowers and widows. Children dependent on single persons, children both of whose parents were dead, children whose fathers were not residing in the State on Census night, nieces, nephews, grand children, etc. supported by married men or by the widowed section of the community were all excluded. Thus the total number of dependent children recorded was 762,063 or 87.1 per cent of all children under 16 years of age. The corresponding percentage of all such children classified as dependent at the 1926 Census was 92.0. The decrease in the proportion of children classified as dependents may be due in some measure to the larger number of married men living abroad on Census day in 1946 than in 1926. There were 407,505 married men and 416,566 married women recorded in the State in 1926 as compared with 424,945 married men and 451,331 married women in 1946. Thus there were 26,386 married men living abroad in 1946 as compared with 9,061 in 1926, in respect of whom dependent children are not included in the totals shown.

It must not be assumed that none of the children classified as dependent were engaged in gainful occupations. While in general the rate of entry into a gainful occupation appears to be somewhat slow in this country, there were in fact 34,964 children under 16 years of age, 23,343 males and 11,621 females, returned as gainfully occupied at the Census. Of this total 16,966 persons, 14,339 males and 2,627 females, were engaged in agricultural occupations.

In calculating the number of dependents for the tables in this volume it has been assumed that in all cases in which the number of dependents was not stated the answer to the question was no dependents. The other information given on the Census schedule was however, scrutinised to ensure that the answers given to this question were in accordance with the other particulars shown on the schedule.

Particulars of dependents in the Volume are classified by areas and also according to the occupation of the married man widower or widow as the case may be. In the tables classified by areas the total number of dependents shown is exact in other words where families of more than 10 children were recorded the actual number of dependents e.g. 12 13 15 was accounted for in the total number of dependents whereas in the tables classified by occupation of parent where there were 10 or more dependents the number was in all cases assumed (because of the system of machine counting) to be 10. Consequently the total number of dependents shown in the Occupations table is somewhat less than the exact total. The number of families however having more than 10 dependents was so small that it did not justify special machine operations to obtain such minute results.

In the 1926 Census Report the numbers of dependent children were shown for married women as well as for married and widowed men and for widows. On this occasion the numbers of dependents of married women have not been shown since the statistics were obtained as a by product of other Census operations which did not yield the necessary particulars. The information in regard to married women would largely parallel that for married men since in the great majority of cases husband and wife are enumerated on the same schedule and it was not considered that the extra data were of sufficient importance to warrant the carrying out of the special machine operations which would be needed to obtain the figures in respect of married women.

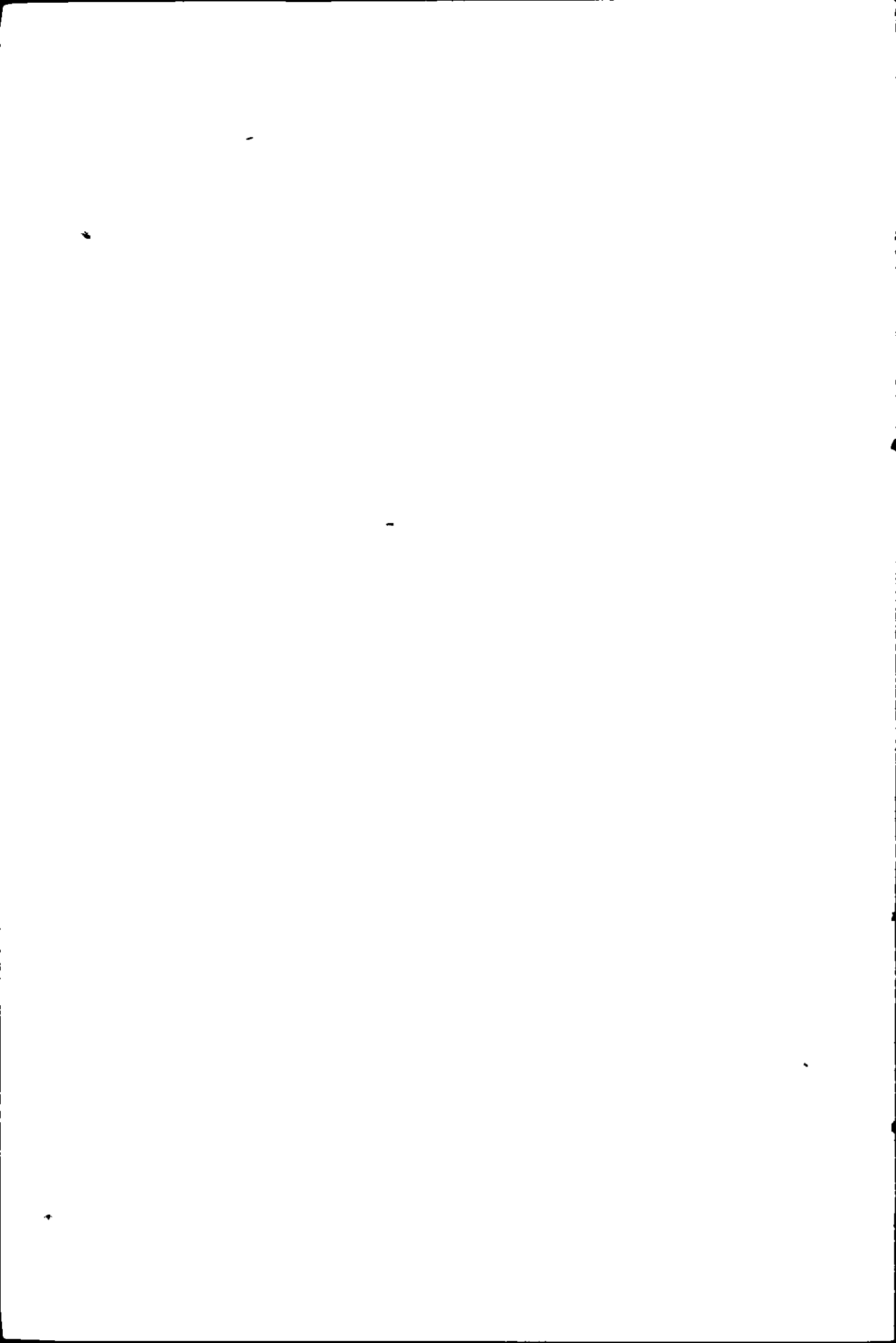
